

Reversible Cupcake Placemat



Easy, Quick to Sew, Fun and Useful

Flower Girl Design Collection

Requirements:

- 1 - yard fabric for Cupcake cup
- ½ - yard fabric for each Frosting, 2 different color fabrics
- 1 -yard fusible fleece

This is for 2 placemats, increase yardage for more



Supplies needed:

- All purpose thread to match fabric
- Scissors & Rotary Cutter
- Pins
- Chalk & Ruler
- Sewing Machine
- Iron

Cutting Fabric:

- Cut 4– 13” h x 15” w –for cupcake cup
- Cut 4- frosting templates, 2 of each color
- Cut 2-13” x 15” fusible fleece
- Cut 2- frosting template fusible fleece

Read through entire pattern before starting to sew.
Remove all pins before sewing over them.

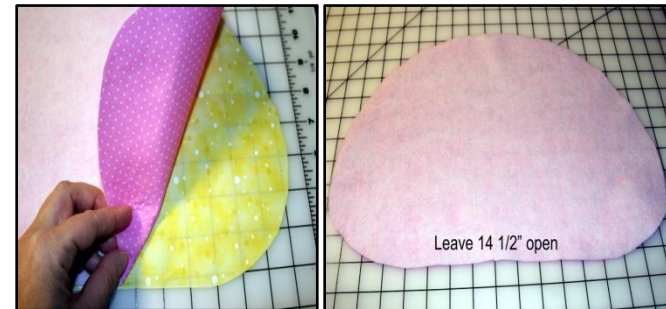
All seams are a ¼”

Reversible Cupcake Placemat:

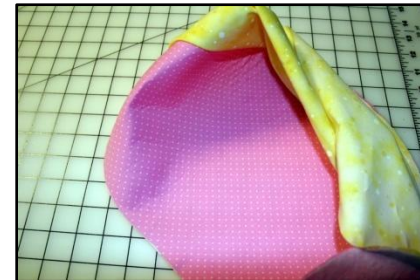
- 1) Iron on fusible fleece Interfacing following manufactures directions to 1 of the frosting templates and 1 cut for the Cupcake cup.



- 2) Place the Frostings right sides together (1 with fusible fleece, 1 without & 2 different colors), fold the Frosting in half finding the middle, measure out 7 ¼” from each side of center and mark with a pin. Pin the rest of the Frosting and sew up to pins, leaving 14 ½” opening.



- 3) Turn right sides out and press.



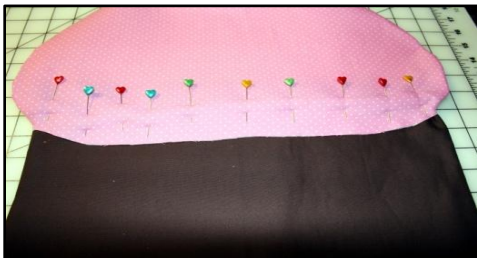
- 4) Place the Cupcake cup cuts right sides together, (1 with fusible fleece & 1 without) leaving a 3" opening for turning, pin and sew.



- 5) Turn right sides out, hand stitch opening closed and press.



- 6) Place Cupcake cup (14 1/2" side after sewing together) approximately 2" into the Frosting and pin in place, making sure front and back Frostings line up.



- 7) Appliqué a zigzag stitch on opening.



- 8) Make some lines on the cup. Take a chalk and a ruler and mark your lines the way you would like them and stitch each line.(optional)



- 9) Topstitch all around the Cupcake.



10) Sew some buttons on the frosting or beads, a big red button for a cherry and you are done with one Reversible Cupcake Placemat!
