

Rick Rack Candle Mat



Fun & Easy to Make

Approximate finished size 14 " x 14 "

Requirements:

- 9- 5" squares or 9 charm squares
- ½" yard backing
- ½" yard fusible fleece
- 1 pack rick rack
- buttons (optional)

Basic Sewing Supplies Needed

Rick Rack Candle Mat

Read through entire pattern before starting to sew. Remove all pins before sewing over them.

All seams are a $\frac{1}{4}$ ".

Cutting Fabric:

9-5" squares or 9 charm squares

Instructions:

Sewing Together:

- 1) Place the 5" squares (charm squares), 3 in each row and 3 rows.



- 2) Sew the squares together, first by rows, place squares right sides together, pin and sew.



- 3) Press row seams in alternating directions. Matching seams sew the rows together.



- 4) Once the rows are sewn together, press the seams on rows in one direction, place the squares on fusible fleece and cut out. Iron on the fusible fleece following manufactures directions.



- 5) Take the rick rack, place and pin it on each row seam. Then sew the rick rack in place.



Finishing:

- 1) Take the squares and place them on the backing, cut the backing out. Place the backing and squares right sides together, sew all around leaving a 3" opening on one side for turning.



- 2) Turn right sides out through the 3" opening, hand stitch the opening closed, press and topstitch all around the edge.



- 3) Add some buttons (optional) and you are done!
