

# Owl Pillow

## Requirements:

3/8 - yard fleece for owl

scraps of felt for face and feet

Lite Heat-n-Bond for face templates

stuffing

Finished size approximately 10" x 9"



## Supplies needed:

All purpose thread to match fabric

Scissors

Ruler

Pins

Sewing Machine

Iron

## Cutting Fabric:

- Cut 2– owl templates
- Cut 4- wing templates
- Cut 2- 4" x 4" felt for outer eyes
- Cut 2- 2" x 2" felt for inner eyes
- Cut 1- 2" x 2" felt for beak
- Cut 2- 5" x 5" felt for feet

Read through entire pattern before starting to sew.  
Remove all pins before sewing over them.

All seams are a ¼".

## Sewing Owl Face:

- 1) Take the 2- 4" x 4" felt for outer eyes, 2-2" x 2" felt for inner eyes, 1- 2" x 2" felt for beak and iron on Lite Heat-n-Bond following manufactures directions.



- 2) Using the outer eye template cut out outer eyes and remove paper backing.



- 3) Take one owl template.



- 4) Take outer eyes (refer to template placement) press in place and sew close to the edge.



- 5) Cut out inner eyes using template, remove paper backing.



- 6) Place on outer eyes, press in place and sew close around the edge.



- 7) Cut out beak using template, remove paper.

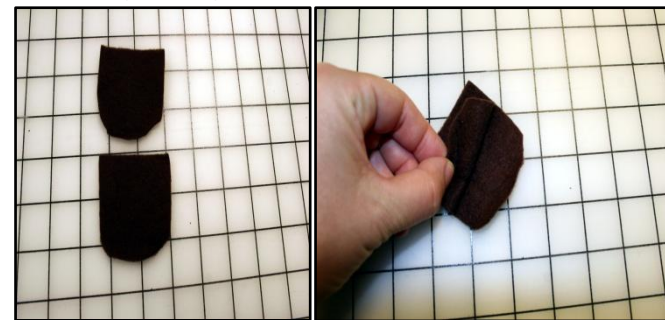


- 8) Place on owl, press and sew all around the edge. The Owl face is done!



### Sewing Wings:

- 1) Take 2 wings, place right sides together, leaving the straight edge open.





2) Turn right sides out.



3) Take the other 2 wings and sew together the same way.



4) Take 1 wing, place on owl below eye, raw edges of wing meeting raw edges of owl and pin in place. Sew a zigzag stitch to secure.

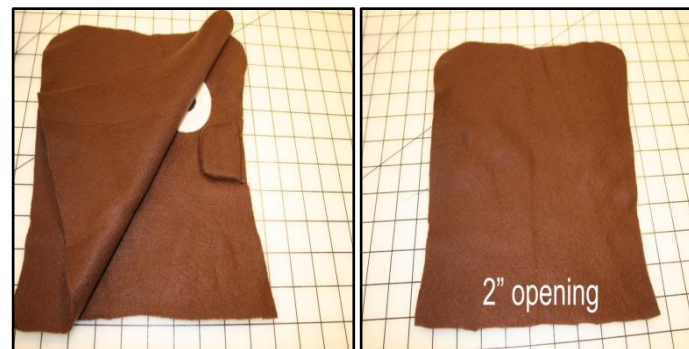


5) Take the other wing, place on the other side of the owl the same way, pin in place and sew a zigzag stitch to secure.



### Sewing Owl Together:

1) Take the other owl template and place it right sides together, (make sure wings stay inside owl) pin all around and sew, leaving a 2" opening at the bottom for turning.



2) Turn right sides out through the 2" opening.

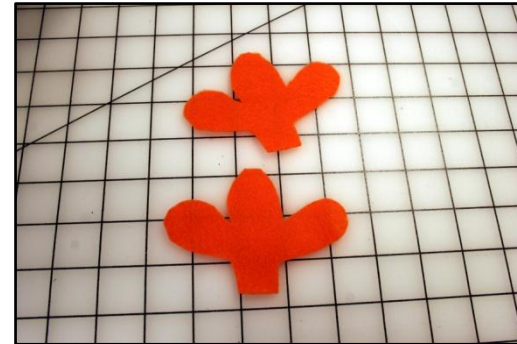


3) Take the stuffing and fill the owl and hand stitch opening closed.

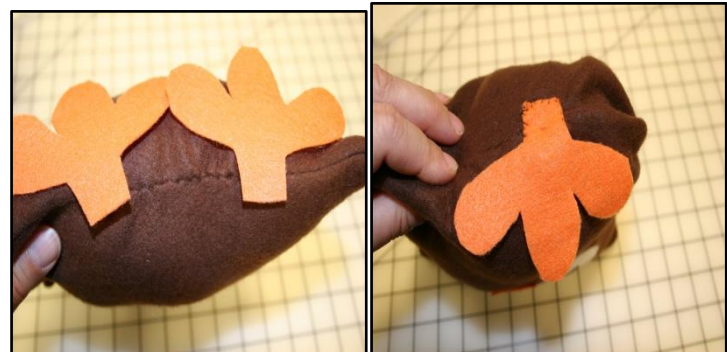


### Finishing:

1) Take the 2- 5" x 5" felt for feet and cut them out using the template.



2) Place them on the bottom of the owl, once you decide placement, hand stitch one at a time in place. Stitch around the end making a box; do not stitch the front of the feet.



3) Your Owl Pillow is done, and how CUTE it is!
